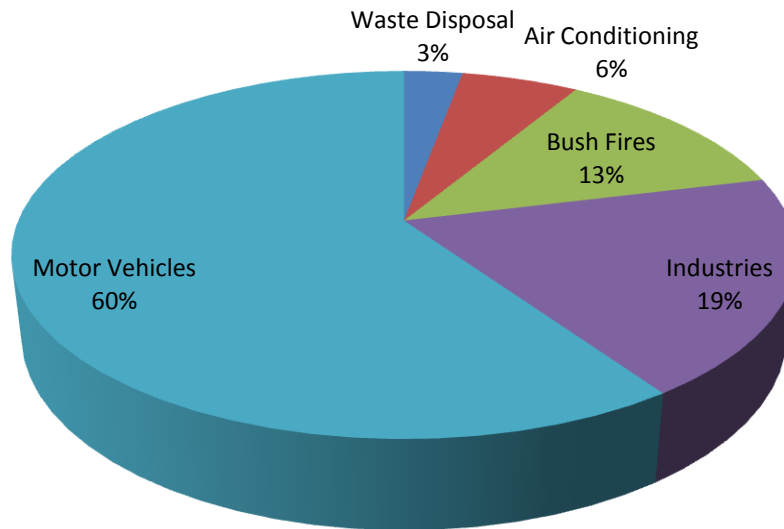


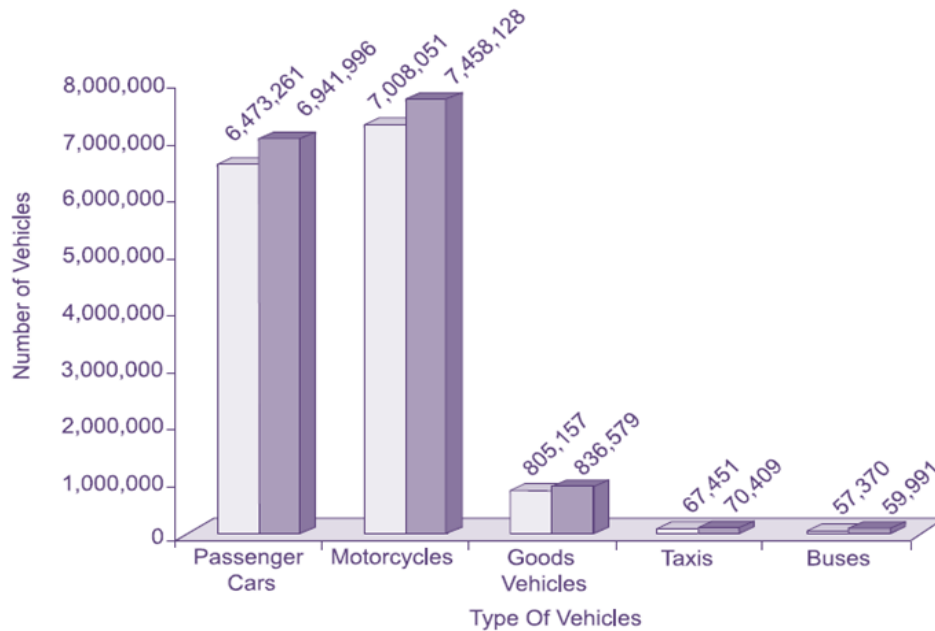
Sources of Air Pollution in Malaysia.
